Dear Parents and Alpine ISD Staff,

Alpine ISD has been notified that a staff member at Alpine ISD has recently tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the information that we have gathered, it has been determined that Alpine ISD will begin a 14-day closure period immediately. At this time, all Alpine ISD campuses, offices, facilities and operations will remain closed until Monday, June 29, 2020.

All summer school instruction for grades PK-8 is cancelled. Summer school for high school students will continue virtually. Administrators for each campus will contact summer school participants individually.

All summer workouts and conditioning will be suspended until further notice.

Our summer meal program will also be suspended until further notice.

Alpine ISD continues to be in contact with our local health care providers and county officials to ensure the health and safety of all our students, families and staff. All buildings will be deeply sanitized prior to reopening.

We encourage everyone to follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines on how to protect yourself from this disease and what to do if you think you are sick.
