**MOVING UP A LEVEL:** Based on the Risk Assessment Criteria

**MOVING DOWN A LEVEL:** Per federal guidelines: If ALL the following criteria are met: 1. Downward trajectory of COVID-19-like syndromic cases reported in the past 14-day period; 2. Downward trajectory of documented cases or percent of cases/population noted in the past 14-day period; 3. Local testing and hospital is not at max capacity

<b>Retail &amp; Other Local Businesses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unrestricted staffing of worksites</li> <li>• Large venues can operate under limited physical distancing protocols (gatherings limited to 50 people)</li> <li>• Gyms, Personal Service businesses (salons, etc) open at normal capacity</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ALL employees advised to work from home - especially high risk individuals - if able</li> <li>• Large venues can operate with physical distancing protocols (gatherings limited to 30 people)</li> <li>• Gyms open at 50% capacity</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Essential business move to 50% occupancy</li> <li>• Construction to only allow one trade at a time on-site</li> <li>• Gyms: Closed</li> <li>• Retail/Personal Service Business: Allowed to be open (using 50% occupancy), but use discretion</li> <li>• All businesses (essential or not) must post signage recommending mask usage</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Essential business move to 10% occupancy</li> <li>• Senior hour of operation at all essential business facilities</li> <li>• Non-essential businesses move to drive-through or curbside only</li> <li>• Public/shared commercial vehicles to single occupancy only (work trucks/crews)</li> <li>• Personal Service businesses: Closed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All essential businesses unable to go curbside or to-go must limit customer occupancy to no more than 10.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Temperatures and symptoms checked at every workplace at beginning of shifts</li> <li>• Curbside/delivery services only</li> </ul>

These Recommendations and Regulations are subject to change by State or County Executive Order.

This chart is progressive. All measures from lower levels are maintained at higher ones, except where they are explicitly changed.
